Key findings:

(each child equates to approx. 0.45% in whole school summary)

6% of our pupils are unhappy in our school (13 pupils)

4% of our pupils feel unsafe in school (9 pupils)

26% of pupils feel children in their class don't behave well (58 pupils) with a further 16% (36 pupils) saying some children don't behave.

17% pupils don't think pupils in our school are friendly. (38 pupils)

100% of our pupils like their teacher.

4% don't think their teacher is kind and fair (9 pupils)

4% don't think their teacher helps them when they are stuck (9 pupils)

9% don't know who to talk to when they are worried about something. (20 pupils)

6% don't think an adult will listen to them when they have a problem. (13 pupils)

5% of pupils don't think or not all the time make lessons fun (11 pupils)

6% of pupils don't think they learn a lot in class (13 pupils)

25% of pupils don't think or are not sure the level of challenge in their work is right (56 pupils)

12% of pupils aren't happy with the amount of homework (27 pupils)

8% of pupils don't think an adult will help if someone is getting hurt, bullied or has a problem (18 pupils)

10% of our pupils don't know what to do if they are bullied (23 pupils)

25% are not sure they understand our school vision and ethos (56 pupils)

Agreed actions:

Whole school collective worship to focus on ethos and vision

Individual art/house group work on ethos and vision

Class work on bullying- re-establish procedures etc

Lunchtime supervisor behaviour management monitoring to improve adults listening and dealing with issues

Yr5/6 Pupil action group leading on behaviour, friendliness etc

SLT monitoring of behaviour

Individual teachers to work with individual pupils who are unhappy, etc

Class work on changing perceptions

Survey to be carried out in the summer term to see if improvements
