### **NHS Pupil Health Services**

The Schools Immunisation team are offering nasal flu vaccinations to all children in reception and years 1,2,3,4 and 5. Parent consent needs to be made online at www.kernowimmunisations.co.uk/flu using the school's unique reference code – **EE142804.** Consent must be given before immunisation can take place. Our vaccination date is 18<sup>th</sup> October – please ensure consent is given at least 2 days prior to this. The NHS School Nurse service are offering free hearing screening for Year 1 pupils again this year on the 27<sup>th</sup> November. Letters will be sent out nearer the time.

### **Parent Views**

Every year, during spring term we carry out a full parents' survey. In the meantime we'd like to repeat our mini traffic light survey for quick feedback on your child's learning to support our continuing drive to improve. Green – something we do well to support your child's learning, Amber – something we could develop or improve, Red something you think we should change to improve your child's learning. These slips will come home with your child to complete and return by half term please.

### <u>Attendance</u>

In-line with government statutory requirements and other schools nationally, we are continuing to work hard on improving attendance in the school as it has such an impact on children's learning and progress. Following advice from our Educational Welfare Officer, who monitors attendance in the school, we will not authorise term time holidays unless in exceptional circumstances. All absence requests must be made via an absence request form which lists the valid reasons for a child's absence from school. Our whole school target is to be greater than 95% - this includes lateness which is marked as unauthorised after 9.20am. Any child who drops below 90% flags up as a concern – in real terms this equates to almost a month off school which has a huge impact on their learning. Please do see me if you have any concerns over your child's attendance. The last week's attendance percentages are:
