St Catherine's C of E School Autumn Newsletter 6- 7.12.18



Over the next 2 weeks all of our KS1 and 2 children will be completing end of term assessments. These assessments support teachers in seeing what the children know and what they need to be taught next. They also support the pupils in understanding their next steps and at learning how to be efficient and effective in completing assessments, applying what they know. These assessments help us to see if the school improvement initiatives we are implementing to support pupils writing and maths progress are effective and what else we need to do as a school to keep improving outcomes for our pupils.

Science Day

Mrs Roberts our year 6 teacher and Science lead organised a whole school science day last week. The children completed a full day of science in all areas of physics, chemistry and biology. We saw lots of wonderful practical experiments happening across the school and the children presented their class work in assembly. The children had a very exciting day and we're looking forward to our next science day!

Consultation on the Extension of An Daras Multi Academy Trust

The Board of Directors of the An Daras Multi Academy Trust (ADMAT) are consulting on a decision to apply to the Department for Education to extend the number of local schools within the Trust. This would see the MAT expand from its current seven schools to eight schools. This planned expansion is in part due to guidance from the Regional Schools Commissioner on predictions of the minimum viable size (based on total pupil numbers) for existing multi academy trusts. It would also support further collaborative school improvement initiatives across the wider locality to help ensure standards of learning provision are enhanced. The expansion proposal is for Princetown Community Primary School to become a full partner school within An Daras. Further details about the proposed changes will be accessible on the An Daras MAT or Princetown Community Primary School website. The An Daras consultation window for wider stakeholders on the proposed expansion starts on Wednesday 5th December 2018 and ends on Wednesday 16th January 2019. Christmas Performance Rehearsals and Performances

KS2 will be going to St Mary's to rehearse their Christmas service on Thursday 13th December in the morning. Children will need to be dropped off at the Church at 9am. Any breakfast club pupils will be taken down to the church from school but please let us know in advance.

Reception and KS1 will be going to Central Methodist to rehearse on Tuesday 18th in the afternoon. We ask that, if possible, children have a school dinner that day and then bring a packed lunch/picnic tea for late afternoon. To aid the smooth running of the rehearsal and set up for the evening performance, children may remain at the church after school until the performance is complete. Parents may join us at Central Methodist for the performance – doors will open from 4.30pm for a prompt 5pm start. **KS2** will perform on **Monday 17th** December at **St Mary's Church** from **6pm. Reception and KS1** will perform on **Tuesday 18th** at **Central Methodist Church** from **5pm**.

Letters have been sent home this week for you to order this for your child, please complete the slip on the letter and return with your payment of £2.30 (no payment required for infants or free school meals) by **Monday 10th December** at the latest in a named envelope to their class teacher. 
Outside school issues
