

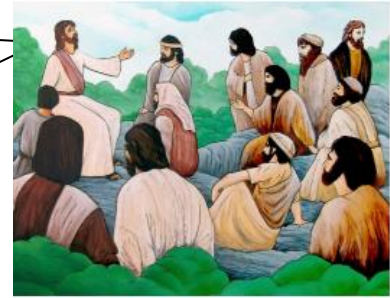

- ✚ Christians believe Jesus brings good news for all people.
- ✚ Jesus offered **friendship**, **forgiveness** and **peace**.
- ✚ Christians believe Jesus' teachings make people think hard about how to live and show them the right way.

Outcomes

- Tell stories from the Bible and link with 'Gospel' or good news.
- Explain what Bible texts mean to Christians.
- Recognise that Jesus gives instructions about how to behave.
- Give two examples of how Christians bring good news to their communities.
- Think, talk and ask questions about whether Jesus' good news is just for Christians or if there are things for anyone to learn.

disciples	The followers and friends of Jesus
Tax Collector	A person that collects money for the king
peace	No arguments or war
neighbour	A person near to you
forgiveness	Not being mad when someone hurts or upsets you—forgetting it happened
pray	To talk to God
