The Wright brothers	Orville and Wilbur Wright were American mechanics and inventors of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, who achieved the first sustained flight of a heavier-than-air machine — what we today call an aeroplane. Their flight was made at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina, in 1903.
Kitty Hawk	Kitty Hawk is a town in Dare County, North Carolina. Kitty Hawk became world-famous after the Wright brothers made the first controlled powered airplane flights on December 17, 1903.
The Wright flyer	The Wright Flyer (Flyer I or 1903 Flyer) was the first successful heavier- than-air powered aircraft.
