FOUNDATION CLASS

At St Catherine's we have a foundation class which can facilitate up to 30 children. The classroom is full of natural open-ended resources to spark the children's curiosity. Attached to the classroom is a large wrap

around outside learning environment with private grass area. These areas are open to the children daily and are an integral part of their learning experience.





What skills does my child need before starting school?

We ask that children are independent in their personal care. We understand that accidents happen and are prepared for this. We ask that in the majority of cases your child is able to change themselves if and when needed.

What equipment does my child need?

We will provide everything your child needs for their learning. We just ask that you bring your child to school on time everyday to access their learning.

Will my child need a packed lunch?

We provide a free hot meal to every reception child. A menu will be sent home with meat, vegetarian and sandwich options for each day of the week. If you would prefer to send a packed lunch you can but there is no refrigerated facility for lunches in the FS2 room.

Will my child get homework?

In Foundation we believe that the most beneficial way to support your child's learning is to listen to them read every day. Although we will share additional learning opportunities with you these are not "formal" homework task and are there to support your child's development.

Is there wrap around care?

Yes, we have a breakfast club that opens at 8am for those families that need to drop off a little earlier. This club is open to all ages from Nursery to year 6. An afterschool club is available for children from Nursery-Year 6 for an additional charge. Running until 5pm
