You will see that we have tried to arrange, where possible, for the children in each class to have familiar staff with them as they move up. However, to further support transition, we have arranged for the children to spend an afternoon with their new class teacher and TAs. This will take place in the week of 12th July. The children will have an afternoon of Sports Day activities and a picnic on the field. We will send out further details nearer the time. You will also receive a slip to complete with anything specific you'd like to pass on to their next teachers. Teachers will also be meeting each other that week to pass on relevant information to the new teacher. When we return in September, we will be holding 'Meet the teacher' meetings after school in order for parents to meet their child/ren's new teachers.

Annual school reports will be sent out mid-July period via our electronic system again.

Our plans for uniform going forward are:

All pupils will need:

- A school sweatshirt or cardigan (can be ordered via Mapac)
- A white poloshirt
- Black (or grey) trousers, jogging bottoms or skirt (no other colours)
- Black, grey or white trainers or shoes (no other colours)
- Black, grey or white socks or tights (no other colours)
- A green bookbag
- A waterproof coat
- Wellington boots.

For PE:

- T-shirt in House Colour or plain white (no other colours)
- Black or grey shorts, skorts, leggings or joggers (no other colours)
- Sports trainers in black, grey or white.
- (If a hoodie being sent for warmth it must be school colour or black or grey plain)

We are hoping, dependent on the national situation and updated guidance from the Department for Education, that in September we will be able to resume our normal timetables and routines but will inform everyone as soon as we know more.
